**AskAndy – Alive and Still Kicking And Not Dead Yet** – came out of a conversation with Bev Brazier (pastor, Whitehorse United Church) about seniors who don't have family in Whitehorse.

Are there ways to help one another be safe and supported? For example,

- whom would you call if you needed serious help?
- who here knows where your important papers are?
- who will notice if you are ill?
- who will contact your family away in case of emergency?
- who will serve as local contact for your family?

Twenty-three people came to our original meetings last Spring. Of that group seventeen have joined one of three subgroups (“pods”). Each pod serves as “family” for the members of the pod, with information being shared and responsibilities taken as the particular pod decides.

We expect to meet Thursday, January 18 at 2 PM (Whitehorse United Church) to form more pods.
